RESPONSE TO AN OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

On 14 April 2023, your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request for information about GETS tenders was partially transferred to the Ministry for Pacific Peoples (the Ministry) from the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) as some of the information is more closely connected with the Ministry's functions. I have outlined your specific request and my response below.

...the number of GETS tenders, per year, covering the last 4 years, in all and any aspects of cloud computing, that specified a preference for Microsoft and/or Azure and/or AWS and/of Amazon and/or Google systems/products/services and any combination of these

On 29 March 2023 you clarified your request with MBIE for the following:

On 11 April 2023 you clarified your request with MBIE further for the following:

By way of narrowing this down, I am only interested in the 285 (central government / public service departments

I can confirm that there have been no GETS tenders at the Ministry that specify a preference for any of the systems and services listed within the requested period. I am therefore refusing your request in full under section 18(e) of the OIA as the information requested does not exist.
