# **RESPONSE TO AN OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (REF: DOIA043-2023/24)**

On 29 January 2024, you contacted the Ministry for Pacific Peoples (the Ministry) requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), information relating to internal communication about a politician's Guy Fawke's comment regarding the Ministry. I have outlined your specific request and my response below.

I'm getting in touch under the Official Information Act to please request all internal communication about David Seymour's Guy Fawke's comment regarding the Ministry.

The Ministry has identified three documents within the scope of your request. Appended to this letter are copies of the correspondence (refer **Appendix 1**).

Some information has been withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the OIA to protect the privacy of natural persons. I am satisfied that there are no other public interest considerations that render it desirable to make the information withheld under section 9 of the OIA available.

In line with standard OIA practice, the Ministry proactively publishes some of its responses to OIA requests. As such, this letter may be published on the Ministry for Pacific Peoples' website. Your personal details will be removed, and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you or your organisation.

NR Let's move to yesterday. Your statement yesterday, said 'my fantasy would be to send a guy called guy, called Guy Fawkes in there, and it would be all over'. So that's for the Ministry for Pacific Peoples, so Carmel Sepuloni has asked you to apologise. Have you?

DS No, no. Let's get real here. It's clearly a joke. It's a joke I have used dozens, probably hundreds of times about various government departments that people are frustrated with, that have been hugely wasteful. The Ministry of Pacific people only being the latest one that gave one hundred and twenty-one dollars [sic] of pressie cards away - for what purpose nobodies, clear. I think that's really just frankly ridiculous that people are even talking about this. I even said it's clearly a joke for people that needed it spelt out. What have we come to New Zealand, where people actually think this is a serious issue?

NR So you do think there was a better way you could have expressed your opinion? Because I think sometimes there's the power of words that, you know sometimes, perhaps that...people in public positions, they've got to be very careful with what they do, for people that might, you know, might not be as even minded as we are.

DS Well, you could make that argument, but if we did that, we would live in a world where nobody would ever express themselves and say anything, in fact I think today the danger, Nathan, is that people up and down New Zealand - actually across the rest of the western world - are a little bit tired of the cancellation, the censorship, the sense that you're not allowed to express yourself, and if you say the wrong thing the world will come down on you like a pile of bricks. It's what - 57, 58 days away from an election. We've got a government that's wasting money, hand over fist, and your firstly asking me about an obvious joke that has no real importance whatsoever, but hey, look it's your interview. You can ask what you like.
