Typically, immediately after a hazard event, the level of uncertainty around the situation can lead to an over-estimation of the perceived level of risk. Over time, this view of the risk level may decrease as more is learnt about the situation and the implications on life safety risk. Although the perceived level of risk may be high immediately post event, it is preferable that a yellow placard (Y1) are applied where possible to allow as many residents as practically possible are able to stay in their homes.

Assessment of existing damage to a building will require an assessment from a structural engineer to determine the integrity of the building. It is not the role of the geotechnical professional to undertake this assessment, and as such, geotechnical engineers are unlikely to apply a R2 placard.
